## **Driving Directions to the 4RK9s Dog Training Club**




#### From I-380 North:

Exit 5th Ave. SW, continue on 3rd St. SW to 2nd Ave. SW. Turn left onto 2nd Ave. SW (one way) and stay in right lane. Continue to 10th St. SW, then turn onto 10th St. SW. 4RK9s is to your immediate right. From I-380 South:

Exit 1st Ave. W. Turn right onto 1st Ave. (headed west) and get in the left lane. Continue to 10th St. Turn left onto 10th St. SW. 4RK9s is located on the left behind the alley.
